Si rimanda alle considerazioni sviluppate all'indomani dell'entrata in vigore della Legge 190/2012, pubblicate sul sito nella Relazione dell'anno 2013, quando il sottoscritto segretario comunale si è accinto ad espletare la nuova funzione attribuitagli "ope legis" con disciplina ed onore in ossequio al precetto costituzionale facendo immediato ricorso alla funzione di supporto istituzionale prevista dall'art.1 comma 6 della succitata legge 190/2012, inoltrando formale richiesta alla Prefettura di Alessandria al fine di ottenere il necessario supporto tecnico ed informativo ai fini della predisposizione del Piano.
